

Retracement of E. ldy. of secs. 1 and 12 T. 12 N. R. 27 E.

Chains

a meridian with the solar and mark a pt thereof on a piece of wood firmly nailed to a stump of a tree about 3 chs. dist.; from cor.
The rest of the afternoon was spent in retracing line true S. bet. secs. 6 and 10 on Tp. line, bet. T. 12 N., R. 27 E. and T. 12 N., R. 28 E.

Thence we run S. bet. secs 1 and 6, 12 and 7 to retrace E. ldy of secs 1 and 12 T. 12 N. R. 27 E. for further identification and check on the above Tp. cor.
