Retracement of E. Eddy. of secs. 1 and 12 T. 12 N. R. 2

Chains a meridian with the solar and mark a pt thereof on a piece of wood firmly nailed to a stump of a tree about 3 chs. dist.; from cor. The rest of the afternoon was spent in retracing line true S. bet. secs. 6 and 1 on Th. line, bet Th. 12 N. R. 27 E. and T. 12 N. R. 28 E.

Hence we run
S. bet. secs 1 and 6, 12 and 7
to retrace E. Eddy of secs 1
and 12 T. 12 N. R. 27 E. for
further identification and
check on the above Th. cor.

39.93 Intersect E. and W. line 13 mks. E. of
old $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. which is a pine
pine now 18 mks. in diam.,
with two bearing trees as
described by the U. S. Surveyor
General.

30.08 Summit of main ridge, bears
S. $20^{\circ} E.$ and N. $20^{\circ} W.$
