

Survey of S. ldy. of T. 13 N., R. 28 E.

Chains

Soil, sandy, 3 d rate.

No timber.

Land covered with dense undergrowth of sage-brush and greasewood, ss. 00 chs.

E. 1st. Secs. 36 and 1.

8.00 Cross road from Schurz to Walker Lake, bears N. 20° W. and S. 20° E.

24.00 Wood road leading down little ravine to river bottom, bears N. 10° E. and S. 10° W.

28.50 Edge of steep bluff by river bottom, bears S. 20° E. and N. 20° W.

30.00 Enter cotton-wood timber and willow at foot of bluff.

40.00 Set a cotton-wood post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. sq. with charred stake, 24 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 36 on N. and 1 on S. face; dig pits, 18 x 18 x 12 ins.
