ins. in a mound of stone,
marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face, for

- 474.45 Found a stone about $17 \times$
 6×5 ins. in a mound of
stone, marked with 6
notches on N, E, S, and W. edges,
for cor. of Tps 13 and 14 N
