

Survey of S. bdy. of T. 14 N., R. 27 E.

Chas. Aug 26: At 7th, 10^m a. m., l. m. t.,
we set off $38^{\circ} 59'$ on the
lat. arc; and $10^{\circ} 28' N$ on the
decl arc; and determine
a meridian, with the
solar at cor of Tps. 13 and
14 North Rs. 27 and 28 E.
as established by us
July 18, 1904.

Thence we run
W. bet. secs. 36 and 1
Over gently sloping ground;
ascend.

34.00 Road from Schurz to Springtown
bears $N. 60^{\circ} W.$ and $S. 60^{\circ} E.$

40.00 Set a redwood post, 3 ft. high,
3 ins. sq., with marked
stool, 24 ins. in the
ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.,
marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 36 on N. and
1 on S. face; dig pits, $18 \times$
 18×12 ins. E. and W. of
cor., 3 ft. dist.; and
raise a mound of
earth, $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft
high, N. of cor.; ascend
gentle slope.
