

Survey of N. bdy. of T. 14 N., R. 28 E.

E. bet. secs. 3¹ and 6.

Over mountainous and broken ground.

Ascend mountain side to

Top of ridge, 200 ft. high,
bears N. and S.; descend.

Hollow, 60 ft. deep, coarse
S.; ascend.

Ridge, 50 ft. high bears N.
and S.; descend.

37.67 Set. a lava stone, 20 x 6 x
5 ins., 15 ins. in the
ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.,
marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face;
and raise a mound
of stone, 2 ft. basl., $1\frac{1}{2}$
ft. high, N. of cor.
Pits impracticable.

Then over rolling ground

to

51.08 Ravine, 30 ft. deep, coarse S.;
ascend.

60.00 Ridge, 20 ft. above ravine,
bears N. and S.; descend

70.00 Base of steepest descent.

77.67 Pt. for sec. cor. falls in
sage flat and we
