

Survey of E. bdy. of T. 12 N., R. 28 E.

Chains Sept. 17: At 7th 55 m. a. m.
l. m. l., we set off
2 1/2' N. on the decl. arc;
and observe the sun
on the meridian at cor.
of Tps. 12 and 13 N., Rs. 28
and 29 E. which we
established July
27, 1904.

The resulting lat. is
38° 05' 31".

Thence we run
S. bet. secs. 1 and 6 over
level land.

18.00 Enter river bottom also
edge of cotton-wood
and willow timber,
bears N.W. and S.E.

30.30 Left bank of Walker River
course E.

32.30 Rt. bank of Walker
River; thence through
scattering cotton-
wood and willow
timber and sage-
brush.

40.00 Set a cotton-wood post
