N. face; and raise a
mound of stone, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ft.
base, 2 ft. high, N. of cor.

40.36 Edge of Walker Lake

Set a granite stone, $19 \times 8 \times 5$
ins., 14 ins. in the ground,
for meander cor. of
frac. secs. 6 and 31
marked M C on
W. face and raise
a mound of
stone, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base
2 ft. high, W.
of cor.
