

- Subdivision of T. 14 N., R. 27 E.
- Chains Aug 27: At 8 h 4^m A.M.,
 l.m.t., we set off 38°
 $59'$ on the lat. arc; $10^{\circ} 6' N.$
 on the decl. arc; and
 determine a meridian
 with solar, at cor. of secs.
 35 and 36, 1, and 2,
 which we established
 Aug 26, 1904 on S. bdy of T.
 The mean magnetic declination was $17^{\circ} 45' E.$
 Then we run
 $N. 5^{\circ} 1' W.$, bet. secs. 35 and 36.
 Over slightly ascending land.
- 27.00 Dry wash, 3 ft. deep, course
 $S. 88^{\circ} E.$
- 36.00 Road from Schurz to Georgetown,
 bears $N. 73^{\circ} W.$ and
 $S. 75^{\circ} E.$
- 36.30 Short dry wash, 3 ft.
 deep, course $S. 88^{\circ} E.$
- 40.00 Set a granite stone, $18 \times$
 10×8 ins. 12 ins. in the
 ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
 marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face;
 and raise a mound
 of stone, 2 ft.
 base, $2 \frac{1}{2}$ ft.
