Chains No timber or vegetation except sage-bush and grease-wood.
 Mountainous land, 39.91 chs.

Returned to $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.
 common to the two
 quarters of sec. 12 only.
 Thence we run

N. on a random line,
 on N. half of line, bet.
 secs. 7 and 12.

40.18- Intersect E. and W.
 line, 34 lbs. west of
 old cor. of secs. 6, 7, 11
 and 12 which is a
 trap stone, 18 x 12 x 6
 ins in a mound
 of stone as described
 by the U. S. Surveyor
 General. Marble C.
 This old cor. stone
 with one notch on
 N. and 5 notches on
 S. edge, to make it
 common to the two
 secs. 1 and 12 only.
