

Meanders of T. 12 N., R. 28 E.

Oct 14, 1904. I begin at the meander cor. of frac. secs. 19 and 24 on the E. bdy. of T. 12 N., which we established Sept 19, 1904.

At this cor., Oct 14, I set off $38^{\circ}31'$ on the lat. arc and $80^{\circ}7'$ on the decl. arc; and at 8^h 20^m l. m. t., determine a meridian with the solar.

Thence I run up the meanders of sec. 24.
