

Resurvey of the 5th St. Par. N. Through R28E

Chains. Survey commenced July 4, 1905, and executed with a Leitz light mountain transit with solar attachment. The horizontal limb having two Verniers placed opposite to each other and reading to one minute of arc.

The instrument was examined, tested at the University, Reno, Nev. found correct, was approved by the U. S. Surveyor General for Nevada, June 29, 1905

I began at the standard township cor. to T. 26 N. Rgs. 28 and 29 E. on the Fifth Standard Parallel North; which is a basalt stone 15 x 10 x 8 ins. loose in a few small stones on top of the ground marked with 6 grooves on E. N. and N. faces and SC on N. face at a point 2.78 ft South of said standard corner in
