 mkd. "4 on W. face, and raise
 a mound of stone $2\frac{1}{2}$ ft base
 $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft high W. of cor.

84.50 Intersect temp. closing cor,

 6 grooves on E. W. and S. faces and
