18.00 Gullet course S.W., thence up a Rhyolite hill.

30.00 Top of ridge bears S.W. and N.E. descent.

35.00 Foot of hill.

40.00 Set a black lava stone $20 \times 12 \times 10$ ins., 15 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. mkd $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face, and raise a mound of stone 3 ft. base 2 ft high N. of cor.

At point of intersection set a basalt stone $24 \times 10 \times 8$ ins., 18 ins. in the ground for closing cor. for sec. 1 and 2, mkd CC. on S. with 1 groove on E. and 5 grooves on N. face, and raise a mound of stone 3 ft base 2 ft high S. of cor.
