

Re-survey of

Sixth Standard Parallel North
through Range 52 East Mount D.B. ^{and} M.

Being unable to find the Standard Township corner to Township 31 North Range 52 East M.D.M., I go to the Standard corner of Sections 32 and 33 Town- 31 North, Range 52 East, which is a Ju- niper post 4 inches square 2 feet above ground marked and witnessed as described by the Surveyor-General.

July 1st., 1904.

At 9 hours and 15 minutes A.M. local mean time I set off 40°30' on the lat- itude arc and 23°07'N. on the declina- tion arc and determine a meridian at the Standard corner of Sections 32 and 33 above-described; thence I run west on south boundary of Section 32.

Descend gradually.

- 1.20 Small gulch 3 links wide; course south.
- 7.00 Road bears N.50°E. and S.50°W.
- 8.20 Road from Palisade to Eureka bears N. and S.
- 10.08 Wire fence bears N. ^{and} S. and enter field.
- 14.50 To center of Eureka and Palisade Rail- road track; bears N.20°W. and S.20°E.
- 21.60 Gulch 5 feet deep and 10 links wide course N.W.
- 24.45 To right bank of Pine Creek.
