

North Boundary Township 31 N. R. 51 E., M. D. M.

M. D. M. which is a basalt stone 16x12x8 inches in mound of stone. Re-established this corner by setting same stone which is marked 4 notches on east and 2 notches on west ~~edges~~ 10 inches in the ground; dug pits 24x24x12 inches in each section 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet distant; raised a mound of stone 4 feet base and 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet high north of corner.

65.00 Draw 90 feet below top of spur, course N.

Ascend.

79.20 Top of spur 150 feet above draw, bears N. and S.

Descend.

80.05 To point 3 links north of section corner of sections 5 and 6 which I destroy.

Land mountainous; soil 3rd. rate;
Mountainous lands 80.05 chains.

July 8th., 1904. At 10 H. and 30 M. local mean time I set off 40°35' on lat. arc and 22°29' $\frac{N}{\wedge}$ on dec. arc, and determine a meridian at point where corner of Sections 5 and 6 was established; thence I run west on north boundary of Section
