

Subdivision of Tp. 31 N., R. 51 E. M. D. M.

- 44.50 Top of spur 350 ft. above ravine, bears S. 50° E. N. 50° W. Descend.
- 51.75 Head of draw 55 ft. below top of spur, course N. E. Ascend.
- 59.00 Top of spur 60 ft. above draw bears N. 35° E. and S. 35° W.
- 71.65 Ravine 150 ft. below top of spur, course N. 40° E. Ascend.
- 77.08 Intersect the N. boundary at a point 15.95 chs. West of Cor. of Secs. ~~33 & 34~~^{34 and 35}, and at point of intersection set a basalt stone 20 X 16 X 10 ins. marked C.C. 6 *grooves* on S., 3 *grooves* on E. and W. faces in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, for closing cor. of Secs. 3 ^{and} 4; raised a mound of stone 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, South of Cor. Pits impracticable.
- Mountainous land.
- Soil 3rd and 4th rate, with growth of sage brush and bunch grass. No timber.
- Mountainous land 77.08 chs.
- From standard Sec. cor. of Secs. 32 ^{and} 33, I run N. 0° 4' W. on a true line bet. Secs. 32 ^{and} 33, Ascend.
- 5.00 Top of spur 35 ft. above Sec. cor. bears S. 50° E. and N. 50° W. Descend.
