

## Subdivision of Tp. 31 N., R. 51 E. M. D. M.

- 66.48 Ravine 35 ft. below top of spur, course N. 50° W. Descend.
- 69.00 Top of spur 48 ft. above ravine bears N. 48° W. and S. 48° E. Descend.
- 77.50 Intersect N. boundary of Township at a point 15.80 chs. west of cor. of secs. ~~31 & 32~~ <sup>32 and 33</sup>, Tp. 32 N., R. 51 E. At point of intersection set a basalt stone 16 X 12 X 10 ins. marked C.C. ~~6 notches~~ <sup>6 grooves</sup> on S., 5 ~~notches~~ <sup>grooves</sup> on E. and 1 ~~notch~~ <sup>groove</sup> on W. faces, for closing cor. of secs. 5 ~~and~~ <sup>and</sup> 6. Dug pits 30 X 24 X 12 ins. crosswise on each line, east and west 4 ft and south 8 ft. dist. Raised a mound of earth and stone 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, south of cor.
- Land mountainous.
- Soil rocky, 3rd and 4th rate.
- Mountainous land 77.50 chs.
