

## Resurvey of Subdivisions T. 12 N. R. 44 E. M. D. M.

Survey Commenced April 13. 1905 and executed with a Leitz transit No 1882 having 2 double verniers placed opposite to each other reading to 1' of an arc.

The instrument was examined and tested on the true meridian at San Francisco, and found correct as per Certificate dated Aug. 19. 1904.

I begin at the Cor. of Secs. 3, 4, 33<sup>rd</sup> & 34 previously described, the record of the observation from which this line was deflected will be found in the field notes of the re-survey of the S. bay. of this township.

Thence I run North on blank line bet. Secs. 33<sup>rd</sup> & 34 and at 40 and 80 Chs. find no trace of old corners so continue N. 5 1/2 miles and after diligent search find no trace of old corners. I therefore return to the Cor. of Secs. 3, 4, 33<sup>rd</sup> & 34 and run

North on true line bet. Secs. 33<sup>rd</sup> & 34 over rolling mesa sloping westerly

- 24.10 ravine 30 eks. wide Course N.
- 40.00 Set lava stone 16 x 8 x 5 ins. 11 ins. in the ground for 1/4 Sec. Cor. marks 1/4 on N. face, raise mound of stone 3 1/2 ft. base 1 1/2 ft. high N. of Cor. *Site impracticable*
- 52.90 ravine 20 eks. wide Course N.
- 60.70 wagon road bears N 60° E. <sup>or</sup> S 60° W.
