

Re Survey of S. bdy. of T20 A. R44 E. M.D.M.

Mountainous Land 39.95 chs.

At the Cor. of Secs. 5, 6, 31^{and} 32 on April 29, I observe by direct observation the lower limb of the Sun on Meridian for latitude as follows.

39.96 To pt. 6 sxs. N. of 1/4 Sec. Cor. a granite stone 12x8x5 ins above ground marked 1/4 on N. face rebuilt mound of stone 3 1/2 ft. base 1 1/2 ft high N. of Cor.

Thence I run

N 89° 55' E. on true line bet. Secs. 6^{and} 31 ascending along northerly slope.

- 23.30 road bears S. N. ^{and} N. E.
- 25.65 ridge bears S 70° N ^{and} N 70° E. and descend
- 29.95 Stream 2 lks wide in deep ravine Course S. N. ^{and} desc ascend

39.96 The Cor. of Secs. 5, 6, 31^{and} 32.
