

Subdivision of T20 N R44 E. M.D.M.

Chains.

- 70.80 Wood road bears $N 40^{\circ} E \frac{1}{2} S 40^{\circ} N$.
- 72.65 Ravine 4 lks. wide Course $S 60^{\circ} N$. and ascend abruptly and enter dense scrub. timber, bears E and N.
- 88.85 Summit of spur bears S. thence along Summit of same. Parallel N.
- 97.75 Intersect 4th Standard, 6.23 chs. $S 89^{\circ} 55' N$. of Standard Cor. to Secs. 33 & 34. Set Lava Stone $15 \times 12 \times 4$ ins. 10 ins. in the ground for closing Cor. of Secs. 33 & 4 marks CC on S. with 3 grooves on E and N. faces. Raise mound of stone $3 \frac{1}{2}$ ft. base $1 \frac{1}{2}$ ft. high S. of Cor. from which
- A pine 10 ins. diam. marked T20 N R44 E. S3 BT bears $S 23 \frac{1}{2}^{\circ} E$. 65 lks. dist.
- A pine 8 ins. diam. marked T20 N R44 E S4 BT bears $S 34^{\circ} N$. 225 lks. dist.
