

Subdivision T16 N R 43 E. M.D.M.

Survey Commenced July 3, 1905 and executed with a Leitz transit N°1882 the horizontal limb being provided with two double verniers placed opposite to each other and reading to 1' of an arc.

The instrument was tested and examined on the true meridian at San Francisco and found correct per Certificate dated August 19, 1904.

From the established Corner of Secs. 25, 26, 35², 36, a description of which will be found in Field notes of Resurvey of Subdivisions in this tp.

Thence I run

descending along steep Easterly slope.

- 5.60 Ravine 3 lks. wide Course S80° E. and ascend
17.60 Spur bears E and descend
25.20 Ravine 4 lks. wide Course SE. and ascend
40.00 Set Sand Stone 20x10x4 ins. in Stone Mound
3½ ft. base 1½ ft. high for ¼ Sec. Cor. marked
¼ on N. face, from which
A pine 14 ins. diam. bears S51½° N. 63 lks. dist.
marked ¼ S 26 BT
A pine 12 ins. diam. bears S60½° E. 15 lks. dist.
marked ¼ S 25 BT

Situate on Summit of spur bears E. and descend
