 80.40 Intersect Reese River Guide meridian  
 N. bay. of Tp. 5. 61 Chs. S. of Cor. of  
 Secs. 12<sup>nd</sup> & 13. Set a granite stone 28x6x5  
 ins. 6 ins. in the ground surrounded  
 by mound of stone 3 1/2 ft. base 1 1/2 ft.
