

## S. Bdy of T 45 N., R 56 E.

Chains

Knowing from the retracement of the Ruby Valley Guide Meridian through R 56 E, and the survey of E. Bdy., that the S. Bdy will not close within limits at the cor. of Tps. 44 and 45 N., R 56 E., on Ruby Valley Guide Meridian, I proceed as follows -

Sept 14, 1904: At 8 h. a. m., l. m. t., I set off  $41^{\circ}44'N$ , on the lat. arc;  $3^{\circ}34'N$  on the decl. arc; and determine a meridian with the solar at the cor. of Tps. 44 and 45 N., R. 56 and 57 E., heretofore described

Thence I run

West, bet. secs. 1 and 36.

Ascend over rocky land, through sage and mountain laurel brush, and bunch grass.

Top of ridge bears NW and SE.

Descend.

Bottom of hollow, 200 ft. below top of ridge, course S.

Ascend.

Top of spur projects S.W.

Descend.
