An aspen 5 ins. diam., bears S. 0° E., 25 lks. dist.,

marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 2 B.T.

A cherry, 3 ins. diam., bears S. 82° W., 4 lks. dist., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 3 B.T.

Leave timber.
