Sept. 27; At the standard
cor. of T_{p.} 46 N. R. 56nd 57 E.
which is a lava stone 10x8x6
ins. above ground. marked
and witnessed as described
by the surveyor general.

At 8 a.m. l. m. t. I set off
41° 50' N. on lat. arc. 1° 35' E. on decl.
arc. and determine a meridian
with the solar.

Thence I run.

N. bet. secs. 31nd and 36

Along E. bdy of the T_{p.}

Ascend along west side of Bruneau
river canon, along steep east
slope through sage and bunch
grass, over rocky land.

22.00 Top of spur, projects E.

Descend.

36.25 Bruneau river 25 lks wide
