41° 50' ~~N~~ on lat. arc. 2° 45' S. on
decl. arc, and determine a
meridian with the solar
at the standard cor. of
secs. 35th and 36, ~~here~~ fore
described.

Thence Down

N. 0° 01' W. bet. secs. 35th and 36
Ascend along steb east slope,
through sage and bunch grass.

31.50 Top of spur, project N. E.

Descend

35.50 Bottom of hollow, 150 ft. dep,
course N. E.
