Chains

marked $\frac{1}{2}$ on N. face, and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, N. of cor.

Pit impracticable.

Begin abrupt descent.

Enter heavy aspen timber bears N.W. and S.E.

Bottom of hollow, 300 ft. deep,
Course N.W. Ascend.

Leave timber, bears N.W. and S.E.

Intersect 9th Stan. Par. North, 1.02 Chs. west of the stan. Cor. of secs. 34 and 35, which is a projecting lava ledge, 2 x 2 x 2 ft. above ground, marked and witnessed as described by the Surveyor general.

Set a granite stone, 18 x 10 x 8 ins., 12 ins. in the ground, for closing Cor. to secs. 34 and 35, marked CC on N. and with 2 grooves on E. and 4 grooves on N. face, and raise
