4.00 Top of spur, projects S. E.

Begin abrupt descent.

32.00 Telephone Creek, 10 fks. wide, 4 ins.

deep, in hollow 400 ft. deep, course C.

Begin abrupt ascent.

Set a granite stone, 22 x 9 x 5 ins., 16 ins. in  
the ground, for  $\frac{1}{2}$  sec. cor., marked  $\frac{1}{2}$  on  
N. face, <sup>and</sup> raise a mound of stone, 2  
ft. base, 1  $\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high, N. of cor.
