Chains

Descend through sage, Laurel  
and mahoganes16.50 Telephone Creek 4 lks. wide, in hollow  
400 ft. deep, course S. E.

Begin abrupt ascent.

Enter heavy aspen timber, bears N. W. <sup>by</sup> S. E.32.00 Leave timber, bears N. W. <sup>by</sup> S. E.40.00 Set a granite stone, 18 x 10 x 8 ins. 12 ins.  
in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., marked  
 $\frac{1}{4}$  on N. face, <sup>and</sup> raise a mound of  
stone, 2 ft. base, 1  $\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high, W. of cor.  
Rite impracticable42.00 Top of spur, projects E.  
Descend.55.00 Bottom of hollow, 100 ft. deep,  
Course E.

Ascend.

71.00 Top of ridge, bears N. W. <sup>by</sup> S. E.  
Descend.78.50 Spring branch, 1 lk. wide, in  
bottom of hollow, 100 ft. deep,  
Course E.

Ascend.

80.04 Intersect 9<sup>th</sup> Standard Parallel  
North, 1.31 lks. east of the stan.
