

RE-SURVEY. W. B'DY T17N., R26E.

Preliminary to Subdividing  
T.17N., R.26E., I retrace the N.  
and W. boundaries to determine  
their condition.

I begin at the cor. of Tps.  
17<sup>and</sup> 18 N. Rqs. 25<sup>and</sup> 26 E. which  
is a Basalt Stone 14x8 ins. 5 ins.  
above ground, mkd. with 6  
notches on N, E, S. <sup>and</sup> W. Edges  
Stone badly cracked and no  
mound or pits. - I destroy  
old cor. <sup>and</sup> re-establish in old  
position as follows: Set  
a Basalt Stone. 14x10x8 ins.  
9 ins. in ground, mkd.  
with 6 notches on N, E, S. <sup>and</sup> W.  
Edges.

T.18 N on N E. face,  
R26 E. on S E. face,  
T.17 N on SW. face,  
R25 E on NW. face and  
raise a mound of Stone  
2 1/2 ft. base 1 1/2 ft. <sup>high</sup> top of cor.  
Pits impracticable.  
Three trees  
South on a blank line  
between Secs. 1 <sup>and</sup> 6.
