fall 55.40 N. of remains of old 1/4 sec cor. a Basalt Stone faint traces of marks, none on ground - no pts or mound.

fall 1.50 2ks. N. of cor. Sec. 5, 6 31. and 32. a Basalt Stone 10 x 10 x 10 ins. loosely set in a mound of stone marked with 5 notches on E. and 1 notch on W. Edges.

after diligent search find no trace of 1/4 Sec. cor.

fall 2.29 Chs N. of cor. Secs. 4, 5, 32^{and} 33. a Basalt Stone 26 x 10 x 10 ins. loosely set in a mound of stone. MK'd with 4 notches on E. and 2 on the edges.

fall 2.33 Chs. N. of 1/4 Sec. Cor. a Basalt Stone 25 x 12 x 10 ins.
