

RE-SURVEY S. T3DY T19N. R25E

Survey commenced Aug. 27-1905
and executed with a Litz 4th
Mountain transit with Burt
Solar attachment. with 2 verniers
reading to a single minute of arc.

Preliminary to the subdivision of
this T^p. I retrace and re-survey
the S., E., W. and N. Boundaries
as follows;

Commencing at the cor. of
Tps. 18th and 19th N. Rqs. 25th and 26th E.
which is a stone 18x8x8
ins. marked with 6 notches
N., E., S. and W. in a mound of
stone as described by the
Surveyor Griff. In Lat. 39° 27' N.
and Long. 119° 02' W., observe
Polaris at Eastern Elongation
on Evening of Aug 27-1905
at 9^h 04^m P.M. L.M.T.
in accordance with instructions
in the manual; and mark
the line by a tack in a peg
firmly driven in ground
