

RE SURVEY W. B. DY. T. 20 N., R. 25 E.

Sept. 23-1905.

At 9h. 22m. P.M. L.M.T. found
the Cor. of T. 20 N. Rgs. 24^{and} 25 E.,
recently re-established by me;

I observe Polaris at
Eastern Elongation and by
reversing the plate, obtain
the middle point ex actly.
which I mark ^{with} a tack on
a stake 10 chs. S. of Cor.

(Stake placed South as unable to
see to N.).

Sept 24-1905 at 7h. 0m. a.m.
L.M.T. Stem off $1^{\circ}34'$

East which is the azimuth
of Polaris from Stake Set
last evening - and set a
Stone $18 \times 8 \times 8$ ins. - 10 ins. in
ground - 10 chs. S. of Cor. across
gully at base of N. Slope. and
Mark exact point by a + on
Stone in a permanent manner
Mean Mag. Var. $17^{\circ}34' E$

Thence I run
North from the Cor. of
T. 20 N., Rgs. 24^{and} 25 E.
