RANDOM-SUBDIVISIONAL LINES

Chavis Sept. 24-1905 8 h. 07 m. a.m.
 I set off $0^{\circ}21'S$ on decl.
 arc and $39^{\circ}35'N$ on lat. arc
 and determine a true Meridian
 with Solar at the cor. of Secs.
 19, 24, 25 and 30. a Pava
 Stone $14 \times 10 \times 8$ ins. 10 ins above
 ground mkd. with 2 notches
 on S and 4 notches on N edges
 with pits in N.W. and S.E.
 Secs. and a mound of earth
 W. of cor. This cor. appears
 to have been marked. lately
 but the pits filled up. I
 re-dug pits to $24 \times 24 \times 12$ ins
 in all four Secs. and raised
 a mound of earth 4 ft. base 2
 ft. high N. of cor.
 Thence I run
 $S. 89^{\circ}42'E$ on a black line
 in search of old $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. and
 Sec. Cors.

3795 I find a stone $16 \times 6 \times 6$ ins.
 mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face, in a
 mound of stone, 35 yds. S.
 of line - no trace of pits
