

RE-SURVEY. 4th ST. PHR. N., S 13 D Y T 12 IN., R 24 E

Survey Commenced.

Oct. 19-1905. and executed
with Litz, light mountain
transit with Burt Solar
attachment & with two verniers
reading to one minute of arc

Oct. 19-1905. — I find
a point which appears to
be the standard cor. of Tps. 20
and 21 N., Rgs. 24 and 25 E.
which is a small basalt
stone 8x4x4 ins. with 6 notches
on all 4 edges, loose on top of
ground. (No trace of post
Cor. as described in notes
furnished by Surveyor General)
with pits N., E. and W. and
mound of earth N.

This point is 3.21 chs. W. of
another apparent cor. which
is a stone 10x6x4 ins. loose
on top of ground without
marks — with traces of pits
N., E. and S.

I also found $\frac{1}{2}$ of a cotton
wood post 20.00 chs. N. E.
