

RE-SURVEY. PYRAMID LAKE I.R. LINE

- chains Nov. 3-1905. 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ 30 m. a. m. Cont.
 I set off 14956' S. on decl. arc
 and 39045' N. on lat. arc and
 determined the true Meridian
 with solar. at the point of
 intersection of the P.L.I.R.
 line with the N. Bdy. of
 T. 21 N., R. 24 E. as re-established
 by me and described heretofore
 There I run
 S. 21° 51' E. on a true line
 with the bearing as furnished
 by the Surveyor Genl. for the
 P.L.I.R. line.
- 5.32 The 11 $\frac{1}{2}$ mile cor. heretofore
 described - I re set the stone
 and repair the mound of
 stone raising it 4 ft. base
 and 2 ft. high -
- 4.00 There descend.
- 20.00 Bottom of deep ravine, ~~cross~~
 SW, then along sandy
 SW. slope.
- 39.80 Found a Basalt rock 20 x 18 ins.
 x 12 ins. - 15 ins. in ground,
 MKd. with T.L. on NE face
