- Chambers mound of stone. Nothing to indicate Standard Cor.
- 200.93 I find a basalt Stone $12 \times 10 \times 2$ ins. loose on top of ground; few stones around it mkd. with $\frac{1}{4}$ on one face. 357 Ks. S. of line.
- 241.21 I find a basalt stone $16 \times 12 \times 2$ ins. not set mkd. with 3 notches on E. and W. edges. 89.2 Ks. S. of line.
- 281.41 I find a basalt stone $8 \times 6 \times 4$ ins. on top of ground - mound scattered - mkd. with $\frac{1}{4}$ on one face. 1.30 chs S. of line.
- 321.21 After a diligent search find no trace of old cor.
- 361.20 After diligent search, find no trace of old cor.
- 401.20 I find a basalt stone $20 \times 3 \times 3$ ins. mkd. with 1 notch in W. and 5 notches in E. edges on top of ground. 1.36 chs. S. of line.
- 441.20 After diligent search I find no trace of old cor.
- 480.46 I find the Standard cor. 2.04 chs S. of line. -- which is.
