

Subdivisions of N. $\frac{1}{2}$ T. 20 N., R. 23 E.

- chains West on true line bet.
secs. 6 and 7, over mountainous land, etc.
- 11.15 Spur, bears S.E.
- 12.20 Ravine, course S.E. and ascend steep slope
- 40.00 Point on E. slope of mountain set a basalt stone 16x8x6 ins. 11 ins. in ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked with $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face and raise a mound of stone 4 ft. base 2 ft. high N. of cor.
Pits impracticable.
- 60.50 High ridge, bears N.W. and S.E.
- 78.00 Brow of ridge thence steeper descent.
- 82.70 Intersect W. bdy. of Tp. 2.12 chs. N $0^{\circ}13'$ E final cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, heretofore described, now changed to refer to secs. 1 and 12 only.
At point of intersection I set a lava stone 18x14x8 ins. 12 ins. in ground for closing cor. of secs. 6 and 7 marked with 1 groove on N.
