- Chambers Nov. 28-1905 / 8 h. o. m. a. m. 2 m. t., I
set off. 21 ¹/₂' S on decl. arc and
39 ³/₄' on lat. arc and determine
a meridian with Solar at the
Cor. of Sects. 13, 18, 19, and 24 ^{henceforth}
described on E & W of T² p.
Thence I run
S. on blank line in search of
¹/₄ sec. and Sec. Cows.
- 39.70 I find a lava stone 12 x 9 x 5 ins.
mkd. with ¹/₄ on one face - 124 ft. S.
E. of line - Stone here in a
scattered mound of stone.
- 80.75 I find a basalt stone 12 x 9 x 6 ins.
mkd. with 2 notches on S. end &
notches on N. E. edges 194 ft. E. of
line.
- 119.30 I find a basalt stone 10 x 6 x 6 ins.
mkd. with ¹/₄ on W. face. 2.96
chs. W. of line, in a mound of
stone.
- 158.61 I find a basalt stone 12 x 10 x 6
ins. mkd. with 1 notch on S. end
& 5 notches on N. edges - 4.96 chs.
W. of line; Set in a mound of
stone.
- 160.49 I find a basalt stone 14 x 6 ins.
