8 ins. above ground mkd. with 1
groove on S, 5 grooves on N. face.
C.C. on E. face, and a mound
of stone 4 ft. base 2 ft. high E. of
Cor., 4.97 chs. W. of line.

I find a basalt stone $12 \times 10 \times 8$
ins. mkd. with $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face in
a mound of stone - with a
mound of stone 5 ft. base 3 ft. high
W. of Cor. 7.29 chs. W. of line

237.02

I find a basalt stone $14 \times 6 \times 6$
ins. in a mound of stone
mkd. with 6 notches on E, S. and
W. Edges, with a mound of
stone $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base 2 ft. high S.
of Cor., 4.31 chs. W. of line.

I also find a stone 2 ft.
above ground 3 ins. sq. in
a mound of stone mkd. with
6 notches on N., E., and W. and
T. 20 N., R. 24 E. on NW. face.
Other marks illegible, 9.97
chs. W. of line. A blazed
Juniper tree stands E. chs. S. of
this corner
