80.20 Intersect E. ldy of T.P., the
 C.R. G.M., 1.44 chs, $S 0^{\circ}02'W$
 of cor. of secs. 25 and 36 hencefore
 described. I obliterate
 the notches on same - and mark
 C.R. G.M. on r.d. face. and
 leave cor. for witnesses of
 alignment.

At point of intersection I
 set a basalt stone $20 \times 8 \times 6$
 ins., 15 ins. in ground for
 closing cor. of Secs. 25 and 36.
 marked with 1 groove on S and
 5 grooves on N. and CC on
 W. faces; raise a mound
 of stone 4 ft. base 2 ft. high
