

Resurvey Fourth Std. Par N. through R20E

- chs. The bearing trees have been cut down, unable to locate Stumps
- 160.41 I find a stake 2 ft. above ground, 3 ins sq. 16 ins N of line marked with
 T 21 N. R 20 E S 32 on NE face.
 T 20 N R 20 E S E on SE face
 S E on SW face
 1 notch on W edge and 5 notches on E. edges.
 A. Cedar tree 10 ins dia. bears S 53° 15' W, 150 chs. dist marked. T 20 N R 20 E S E T 3 T
 no trace of other bearing trees
- 200.41 I find a loose stake, 2 ft. long 3 ins. sq. badly decayed. - 12 ins W of line - no trace of pits or mound
 no trace of bearing trees
- 234.38 I find a pile of loose stones but no stone or stake marked. I identify as the closing cor. of T 20 N., R 9 S. 19 and 20 E., a Juniper tree 10 ins in dia which bears S 15° W 3.60
