RESURVEY of ONE MILE of W. T3DY

May 5-1906. Show am put.

I set off $16^{\circ}11'N.$ on decl. arc
and $39^{\circ}51'N.$ on lat. arc at
the cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36
on W. bdy of T23N., R20E.

which I find to be a
Juniper stake 3 ft. long 3 ins.
sq. nkd. with T23^{N.}R, 19E, 36
on one face.

R20E S31 — on one face

T23N. S30 on one face

R19E S25 on another

face and down but starts
of old stone mound at base
of same.

I destroy this cor. and re-establish
in same point as follows:

Set an accedite stone 20×10
 $\times 8$ ins. 15 ins. in ground for
cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36.

nkd. with 1 notch on S. and
5 notches on N. Edges. and
raise a mound of stone 3 ft.
base 2 ft. high W. of cor.

A Juniper tree 8 ins. in
diam., bears N. $72^{\circ}25'W$
542 Ks. dist. which I mark
