Chains October 11, 1905 a.m. 8th a.m. l.m.t. I employ the meridian determined by observation on Polaris, Oct 8, 1905 at the cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36 on the W. bdy. of T. 54 N. R. 30 E.

Thence I run

North along the E. bdy. of sec. 25
Over nearly level land

4.70 Road bears E. and W.

15.15 Enter dry bed of Humboldt
Lake bears E and W.

40.00 Set a granite stone 16x12x8
ins. 11 ins. in the ground
for. 4 sec. cor. marked 4 on
W. face; dig pits 18x18x12 ins.
N. and S. of stone 3 ft. dist and
raise a mound of earth 3 1/2
ft. base 1 1/2 ft. high W. of cor.

30.00 Set a granite stone 20x10x8 ins.
15 ins. in the ground for cor.
of secs. 24 and 25 marked
with 2 notches on S and 4
notches on N. edge; dig pits
24x24x12 ins. in each sec.
6 ft. dist. and raise a mound
of earth 4 ft. base 2 ft. high
