

Resurvey of the E. bdy. of T. 25 N. R. 31 E.

Chains

Cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face
and raised a mound of
stone 2 ft. base $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high.
W. of cor. Pits impracticable.
Thence Iron

N. $4^{\circ} 28' W.$ bet. secs. 7 and 12
from the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor.

Over rolling land.

The cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12

Land rolling

Soil stony 4th rate.

Scattering low growth
of sage brush.

From the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. on the E.
bdy of sec. 12, previously set
by me Iron south on a blank
line along the E. bdy. of T. 25 N.
R. 31 E. and find no part of
this bdy. in allignment
and that all the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. corners are
obliterated; at 272.50 chs.; the
cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, bears
W. 76 lks; 351.92 chs.; the cor.
of Tps. 24 and 25 N. Rs. 31 and 32 E.
