

Nurvey of Tract. E. Bdy of Tps. 25 N. R. 30 E

Oct. 19, 1905, 8^h am. C.M.T. I set off on my solar 80° 09' the \odot polar distance of the sun, and 40° 00' on the vertical circle and determine a true meridian with the solar at the corner of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, on the E. bdy of T. 25 N. R. 30 E.

Thence I run.

South on a true line between secs. 31 and 36.

Over dry bed of Humboldt Lake.

40.00 Set a volcanic stone 18x7x6 ins. 17 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face, dig pits 18x18x12 ins. on line N. and S. of stone 3 fr. dist and raise a mound of earth 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ fr. base 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ fr. high W. of cor.

75.74 Intersect the N. bdy of T. 24 N. R. 30 E. at S. 89° 59' W. 4.75 chs. from the cor. of Tps. 24 and 25 N. Rs. 30 and 31 E. At point of intersection, set a volcanic stone 27x10x8 ins. 16 ins. in the ground for closing cor. of Tps. 25 N. R. 30 and 31 E. marked c c on N. face
