

Survey of Tract N. bdy of T. 25 N. R. 30 E.

Oct. 21, 1905: At 8^h am. l.m.t.,
I set off on my solar $79^{\circ}26'$ the
S. polar distance of the sun and
 $40^{\circ}8'$ lat. on the vertical circle
and determine a true meridian
with the solar at the cor. of
secs. 13 and 24, on E bdy of T. 25 N. R. 29 E

Thence I run

South on a random line
between Rs 29 and 30 E. through
T. 25 N. setting temporary
 $\frac{1}{4}$ sec and sec. corners at intervals
of 40.00 chs. and at 239.74
chs. intersect the N. bdy of
T. 24 N. R. 30 E at 99 chs. E
of cor. of Tps. 24 and 25 N. R. 30 E

Thence I run

N. $84^{\circ}4'$ E on a true ^{line} on E bdy Sec 36.

Over dry level bed of Humboldt R. R.

39.74 Set a granite stone $19 \times 6 \times 6$ ins
13 ins. in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec.
cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face; dig
pits $18 \times 18 \times 12$ ins. on line N.
and S. of stone 3 ft. dist and
raise a mound of earth $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft.
base $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high W. of cor.
