 pits nearly obliterated, no  
 stake, bears N. 28 lks.
- 80.00 Search diligently within  
 radius of 10 chs, but fail to  
 find any trace of old cor.
- 118.52 The  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. a cedar post  
 2 ins. square 18 ins. above ground  
 mound and pits obliterated  
 bears N. 60 lks.
- 158.73 Cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32 and 33 a  
 cedar post 2 ins. square 3 ft. long  
 lying on the ground on mound  
 of earth, pits nearly obliterated  
 bears N. 76 lks.
- 199.15 The  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. a cedar post  
 2 ins. square 3 ft. long, lying
