Chained on the ground, mound and pits nearly obliterated, bears N 164 lks.

238.89 Cor. of secs. 3, 4, 33 and 34 a cedar post 2 ins square 2 ft. above ground, no sign of pits, mounds nearly obliterated bears N 100 lks.

278.90 The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. which is a plate stone $16 \times 8 \times 7$ ins, improperly marked lying on the mound pits obliterated, bears N 112 lks.

318.93 Cor. of sections 2, 3, 34 and 35 a plate stone $24 \times 14 \times 6$ ins poorly marked, lying on the mound of earth, pits obliterated, bears N 124 lks.

359.05 The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. remains of mound and pits in fair condition no stake, bears N 129 lks.

399.10 Cor. of secs 1, 2, 35 and 36 mound and pits, no stake bears N. 134 lks.

439.18 The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. no signs of stake pits and mound nearly obliterated bears N 141 lks

479.32 Cor. of T₄s. 23 and 24 N of R₉s.
